Villa Lolita offers 14,000 square feet of free-flowing living space. Built on three levels, the villa is surrounded by four acres of landscaped tropical gardens.

The main floor contains the first master suite and guest suite, and the immediate lower floor houses 2 further guest bedrooms. The second master suite occupies its own private lower floor. All suites have flat screen TV's, iPod docking station, double sinks in the en-suite bathrooms and open showers.

The magnificent Michigan Master Suite is located on the main floor and has a secluded terrace, which features a heated infinity plunge pool/Jacuzzi with an outdoor shower. The Ohio Suite is located on the first level and is

handicap accessible with comfort height safety bars throughout. The Washington Master Suite features a connecting living room with a queen size sofa bed, full wet bar with microwave and a garden level patio. The Tennessee Suite features a king size bed and the Illinois Suite includes two queen size beds.

The wraparound terrace has four levels – one is furnished with sun loungers, the second area features a children's pool and the main entertainment terrace surrounds the infinity pool and includes an outdoor dining gazebo, wet bar and several seating areas.

The resort itself has a wealth of activities and amenities including watersports, spa and fitness centre.

The Great House - Guests have access to The Great House Restaurant and Bar. During the winter season, breakfast and dinner are served at the Great House Restaurant and during the summer months, dinner only. Guests can choose to dine by candlelight outside on the terrace overlooking the bay and the distant twinkling lights of Montego Bay or inside in the dining room. Each afternoon at four o'clock, afternoon tea is served on the veranda and terrace.

The Beach Café - Relaxed and informal and set beside the Tryall Club pier and overlooking the ocean, the Beach Café is a delightful lunch venue offering a choice of indoor or al-fresco seating. It is the perfect place to head to after a morning on the beach.

Golf is as much a part of The Tryall Club as the magnificent villas and the ocean views and is rated as one of the Caribbean's finest.

Tennis is also a popular activity at The Tryall Club and has been since it was opened in 1959.
